Part of our daily routine preparation at Crazy Horse Concrete is to anticipate the concerns that may arise at our customer’s job-site. Over the years, we have learned to successfully work together with our customers and have made the necessary adjustments in our operations to address their concerns.

We have no intention of hibernating this winter!

Installing concrete at this time of the year can be especially challenging. It is important, now more than ever, to call in orders at least 24 hours ahead of the delivery time. All our drivers are on layoff. They will gladly work but they need to be called in advance if we want them to work.

For your own benefit, please be aware of the temperature of the day: There are times we get as much as 30 degrees change from one day to the next. We already had concrete poured on a day that that the high temperature was 19 degrees. The contractor was still trying to finish it 20 hours later. The next day it was 36 degrees and those contractors pouring that day finished in less than 8 hours. A week later, we worked with several contractors on a 34 degree day to deliver early.

The following day the temperature dropped to 15 degrees followed by another 15 degree day. Good planning paid off.

Crazy Horse takes precautions to make sure when we mix our materials that the concrete we produce reaches near ideal temperatures. The boiler we use to heat the mix water is currently set at 180 degrees. The hot water is used to bring up the material temperature to 70 degrees allowing the initial chemical reaction to occur in the mixture of materials.

Crazy Horse Concrete has liquid or flake calcium to help shorten the set time of concrete during these cold days. The liquid is added at the plant where the flake can be added on-site just prior to pouring.

Our phone lines are always on. The office is open everyday day of the week and each Saturday morning with either Dan or me to discuss your situation and accommodate your needs.
